<b>9. Submit all measured technical parameters (<math>P_F</math>, <math>P_R</math>, S/N, BER, modulation, etc.) over the past 2 weeks</b>

*Remark: The licensee shall comply with all the technical requirements and performance standards enforced by the BT&P to be considered for interference investigation and protection. An interference claim will not be taken into consideration if it is clear that the trouble complaint is not related to interference. If turns out that the licensee has undeservedly submitted an interference complaint, the licensee will be charged by the BT&P for the costs involved in the investigation.*
