Explanation

Tariffs for electricity and water are subject to the monthly fluctuating fuel costs of production, the correction factors of forecasts and a possible deferred tariff adjustment*. Tariffs for water in July 2015 have stayed almost the same. Tariffs for electricity in July 2015 have increased mainly because of a deferred adjustment from June 2015.

*Monthly tariff adjustments are limited to a bandwidth of plus or minus 10%. Adjustments falling outside of this range are partly deferred to the following month.
