### Explanation

The electricity and water rates will increase in January. This is merely the result of a less ideal mix of production units due to maintenance on production units with lower production costs, but also due to increasing fuel costs. Moreover, in November 2015 the production mix was less favorable than planned for which a correction is included in the tariff.
