Explanation

The slight decrease of the electricity tariffs is comprised of an increase in average fuel expenses resulting from changes in the production mix, which increase is fully compensated by a decrease in the correction factor.

The slight increase in the water tariffs results from an increase in electricity expenses for the production of water also due to changes in the production mix, which increase is partially compensated by a decrease in the correction factor.
