Explanation

The slight decrease of the electricity tariffs is comprised of a decrease in average fuel expenses for the production of electricity resulting from lower fuel prices, and also changes in the production mix. The decrease is partially offset by an increase in the correction factor. The slight decrease in the water tariffs results from a decrease in electricity expenses for the production of water. The decrease is partially offset by an increase in the correction factor.
