Explanation

The miniscule decrease in the electricity tariffs is comprised of a decrease in average fuel expenses resulting for the production of electricity, this decrease is partially offset by an increase in the correction factor regarding November 2019. The increase in the water tariffs is a combination of a slight decrease in electricity expenses for the production of water, which is offset by an increase in the correction factor regarding November 2019.
