#### Explanation

The decrease in the electricity tariffs is caused by a decrease in average fuel expenses, as well as a lower correction factor regarding the month of October 2020. The production costs of water have increased slightly due to the amended production mix, but this increase is however offset by a lower correction factor regarding October 2020, resulting in a decrease of the water tariffs.
