Explanation

The increase in electricity tariffs is a result of an increase in average fuel expenses for the production of electricity which is partially offset by a decrease in the correction factor regarding the month of December 2020. The decrease in the water tariffs results from lower electricity expenses for the production of water which is caused by changes to the forecast production-mix, and also by a lower correction factor for the month of December 2020.
