Explanation

The decrease in electricity tariffs results from slightly higher average fuel expenses for the production of electricity which is caused by the forecasted production mix, which is offset by a substantially lower correction factor for the month of July 2021. The decrease in water tariffs results from higher average electricity expenses for the production of water which is offset by a also substantially lower correction factor for the month of July 2021.
