Explanation

The increase of the electricity and water tariffs is due to an increase in the average fuel expenses for the production of electricity respectively an increase of the electricity expenses for the production of water as well as a higher correction factor for water and electricity for the month of July 2022. This is caused by the actual production mix during July as well as the forecast for September, which includes less electricity production by wind energy and therefore an increased operation of more costly production units. The resulting tariff increasing effects are partially mitigated and will be addressed in the coming month(s).
