Explanation

The slight increase of the electricity and water tariffs is due to a slight decrease in the average fuel expenses for the production of electricity respectively a decrease of the electricity expenses for the production of water in combination with a higher correction factor for water and electricity for the month of August 2022. This higher correction factor is caused by the actual production mix during August, which amongst others included less electricity production by wind energy resulting in an increased operation of more costly production units. The resulting tariff increasing effects are partially mitigated and will be addressed in the coming month(s).
