Explanation

The slight increase of the electricity tariffs is due to a slight decrease in the average fuel expenses for the production of electricity in combination with a higher correction factor for the month of September 2022. The slight increase of the electricity and water tariffs is due to a slight increase of the electricity expenses for the production of water in combination with a lower correction factor for the month of September 2022.
