#### Explanation

The slight decrease of the electricity tariffs is due to a decrease in the average fuel expenses for the production of electricity due to the expected production-mix, including a larger share of energy from wind turbines and an increased operation of more cost-efficient production-units, in combination with a higher correction factor for the month of November 2022. The increase of the water tariffs is due to a decrease of the electricity expenses for the production of water in combination with a higher correction factor for the month of November 2022.
