Explanation

The slight decrease of the electricity tariffs is due to a decrease in the average fuel expenses for the production of electricity due to a decrease in the fuel prices, the expected production-mix (including a smaller share of energy from wind turbines and an increased operation of more cost-efficient production-units) in combination with a higher correction factor for the month of December 2022. The slight decrease of the water tariffs is due to a decrease of the electricity expenses for the production of water in combination with a higher correction factor for the month of December 2022.
