Explanation

The slight decrease of the electricity tariffs is the result of a decrease in the average fuel expenses for the production of electricity due to a decrease in the fuel prices of MGO in combination with the expected production-mix (despite an increased projected operation of the less cost-efficient GT2 Mundo Nobo production-units) and a higher correction factor for the month of May 2023. The decrease of the water tariffs is the result of a decrease of the electricity expenses for the production of water in combination with a higher correction factor for the month of May 2023.
