Explanation

The decrease of the electricity tariffs is mainly the result of an increase in the average fuel expenses for the production of electricity due to an increase in the fuel prices in combination with the expected production-mix and a substantially lower correction factor for the month of July 2023. The decrease of the water tariffs is the result of an increase of the electricity expenses for the production of water in combination with a substantially lower correction factor for the month of July 2023. Furthermore, a new tariff is established regarding irrigation water for purposes of commercial agricultural activities, for which one can qualify under certain conditions.
