#### Explanation

The increase of the electricity tariffs is mainly the result of an increase in the average fuel expenses for the production of electricity due to a substantial increase in the fuel prices in combination with the expected production-mix and a substantially higher correction factor for the month of August 2023. The increase of the water tariffs is the result of an increase of the electricity expenses for the production of water in combination with a substantially higher correction factor for the month of August 2023.
