Explanation

The decrease of the electricity tariffs is the result of a decrease in the average fuel expenses for the production of electricity due to a decrease in the fuel prices in combination with the expected production-mix and a lower correction factor of the month December 2023. The increase in the water tariffs is the result of an increase in the fuel expenses for the production of water in combination with a significantly higher correction factor of the month December 2023.
